Information for Leaders

In Advance

On the Day

Collect One Day Activity Forms for every girl before getting on the coach.
To be retained all day by the Unit Leader or adult accompanying the group.
Girls will need to bring in a named bag:-
Completed One Day Activity Form
Any medication required - clearly labelled with name and dosage
Extra appropriate clothing - waterproofs/sun hat
Sun Screen
Extra snacks for tea time
Extra drinks - bottle of water will be provided with BBQ lunch

Leader to Bring

Small First Aid Kit - 1st Aider from Woburn will be in the Guiding area throughout the day.
On the coach everyone will be issued with a wristband. A leader's mobile number must be written on the band. Ensure everyone except under 3s are wearing the wristband before leaving the coach.

Outline plan of the Day

10.- 10.30 Coaches arrive - toilets available at entrance
Coaches go straight to the Road Safari - this will take approx. 1 ½ hours(so use toilets first if required!)
11.30 onwards Coaches arrive at dedicated Girlguiding area - Division marquees available here.

11.30 for approx. 2 hours BBQ will be served. Please eat at a time to suit your group.

12.00 - 4 pm Free time in Foot Safari

4 - 5.30 Disco with Heart FM - judging of homemade animal masks, Centenary Draw

5.30 - 6 Coaches depart

Everyone will be given a Safari Park map. Please use this to plan your trip. You will be able to use it on the coach during the Road Safari to help spot the animals. Please note the times of all the shows for the afternoon. You are very unlikely to be able to see everything so agree with your group the top priorities.

Please note if you wish to take the train it takes about 15 minutes.

We will have a Guiding display near the Outdoor Play Area (14 on the map) so please visit that too.

Please ensure that girls who do not have photo permission are not included in any group photo.

Every participant will receive a SAFARI 100 cloth badge at the end of the day.

There will be extra Guiding signage in the Foot Safari area to remind you of timings.

If you have any issues during the day please contact a member of the SAFARI 100 team - all wearing SAFARI 100 T shirts, there will always be someone from the team at the Girlguiding area. Elsewhere in the park please ask a member of Woburn Safari Park to contact the Girlguiding Team.

At the end of the day please remain at the disco until you are asked to board your coach for the return journey.
