Hunt Mrs Twit's eyeball

Mr Twit has hidden his horrible wife's glass eye. Can you find it before the Twits?

The game starts with the children covering their eyes while the organiser hides the "eyeball" (this could be a round sweet). The children are then allowed to open their eyes and search the room for the prize. Needless to say the finder keeps the prize and the children all hide their eyes again for round two. It is a good idea to hide one or two extra eyeballs before the party starts. This way if you spot anyone peeping you can make a big show of hiding the eyeball in one location but in reality not hiding it at all. When the children do not find the prize they continue looking until they discover one of your previously hidden ones.

Pin the ears on the Big Friendly Giant

The BFG has extra-usual ears to listen to all kinds of things. Sometimes though, he needs a little help

You will need a large copy of the BFG (a good example is on the back of the 2001 Puffin edition). Carefully cut round his profile and, following the lines of the illustration, cut away his ears. Back with cardboard and fix the rest of the picture to a pin board or similar. The children take it in turns to be blindfolded and attempt to fix the ears in the correct place on the BFG's head. The winner is the one who gets the closest and runner-up prizes can be presented to the others.

Willy Wonka says

Do as Willy Wonka says and you too can be like Charlie Bucket. Get it wrong and end up an Augustus Gloop or a Violet Beauregarde!

The children all stand facing the organiser who asks them to duplicate his or her actions by saying "Willy Wonka says do this" followed by the action (hands in the air, stand on one leg, touch your ear, etc). Any action preceded by the words "do this" without the "Willy Wonka says" part is not to be duplicated. A child is out if they get this command wrong (children who are already out might help as judges). The last remaining child is the winner.

Fantastic Foxes

Mr Fox and his family are trying to escape from the horrible farmers. Help the Foxes to get away!

The children are divided into two or more teams depending on numbers. The team members stand behind each other and each leader is given a "Fox" (this could be a balloon with eyes and whiskers drawn on it). The Fox must be passed down the line

by going over the leader's head to the next child who passes it through their legs to the next one who in turn passes it over their head. In this way the Fox travels down the line to the last child who runs round to the front and starts again. This continues until the team leader is back at the front with the winning team being the first ones to finish.

Poacher

If Danny hears a gamekeeper approaching, he must remain absolutely still otherwise he'll get caught!

Children jump or dance to music and when it is turned off they must stand as still as possible in whatever position they happen to be. Anyone spotted moving is out (children who are already out might help as judges) and the last child in the game wins.
