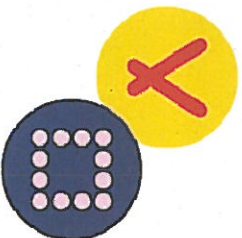

DENMARK'S LARGEST JAMBOREE EVER

From 21st to 29th July 2012, 35,000 children and adults will come together at Jamboree Denmark 2012 in Holstebro in the western part of Denmark. There will be scouts, guides and leaders from the five internationally recognised Danish scout and guide associations, as well as scouts and guides from all over the world. Parents, sisters, brothers of the participants and anybody else interested in joining a scout and guide camp will be welcome!

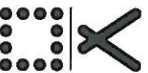
Scouts and Guides of all age groups are invited to participate – either for the whole camp or just a couple of days. You will be expected to set up camp with the local scout or guide group, a joint camp for all ages.

The camp fee is DKK 1775 (€240) including home hospitality. Additional cost will apply for return transportation to Denmark and there may be an extra cost for transportation to your home hospitality (if applicable).

The Home Hospitality stay is 2-3 days before the Jamboree. During your stay at a scout/guide family or a scout/guide house you will experience Denmark and its culture with the local scouts. This will also include an invitation to join a big outdoor event together with 5000 other participants

The jamboree will be like a city with neighbourhoods. There will be six neighbourhoods, consisting of several housing estates, each housing estate will comprise of the scout and guide groups from the same town, city or municipality in Denmark. The international participants will stay with a Danish host group.

The jamboree theme is 'we meet each other – we change the world – I develop myself.'

FACTS ABOUT JAMBOREE DENMARK 2012



Colourful symbols constitute a Jamboree type code language designed especially for the Jamboree Denmark 2012. They act as eye catchers and can be used either together with the Jamboree logo or alone. Everybody can develop the symbols from a circle encompassing a square grid of 16 dots. The dots can be highlighted by colours or connected with coloured lines.

The jamboree is managed by an Executive Team and 12 committees, comprising of a number of teams for each committee. The committees have been set up in accordance with the responsibilities required to plan and organise Denmark's largest Jamboree ever!

The programme will be packed of activities and events for everyone. Participants will need to register for some of the activities in advance. Jamboree Denmark 2012 offers you an opportunity to be involved in a wide range of cultural activities and big events, there will be plenty for all!

Camp Registration is a two stage process – from November 2011 advance registration will be available and final registration March 2012

Policies and Principles form the 'code of conduct' for Jamboree Denmark 2012. A camp that joins together five different scout and guide associations will have a set of common guidelines, which have been decided by the Executive Committee and the Jamboree Supervisory Board.
