This is the fourth international camp organised by the Garwolin ZHP District - the first was in 1995 previously those attending have scouts and guides from UK, France, Germany, Sweden, Kazakstan Holland USA and of course from Poland.

Scouts and guides over 11 years old are invited to take part in our camp. It is planned that each visiting group (10-15 participants) will be partnered with local scout or guide group and they will camp and eat and undertake the programme together.

The camp fee will be in the region of 275 Euro and will include:
